All member appointments are noncompensated. However, NASA does cover travel and per diem expenses for all member appointments.

The deadline for NASA receipt of all public nominations is **December 1, 2017.**

To be considered by NASA, self-nomination packages from interested U.S. citizens must be sent to NASA as an email. The following information is required to be included as part of each self-nomination package: (1) A cover email with subject line, "APAC: self-nomination"; (2) a professional resume (one-page maximum, included as an attachment); and, (3) a professional biography (one-page maximum; included as an attachment) that includes experience and contributions relevant to NASA subject areas. All public nomination or self-nomination packages must be submitted electronically via email to NASA at apac-execse@hq.nasa.gov; paper-based documents sent through postal mail (hard-copies) will not be accepted. Note: Self-nomination packages that do not include the three (3) mandatory elements listed above will not receive further consideration by NASA.
